Oil Spill Response

Operating in the region since 2004, SES has established and now operates a series of Tier 2 oil spill response centres in Georgia. SES also maintains a multinational workforce in Azerbaijan, including a number of experienced Azeri staff trained to international standards. Working in remote locations and a harsh environment, SES has been instrumental in the establishment of a highly reputable response capability in the region.

SES activities have included assistance in the design and positioning of oil spill bases, recruitment and training of over 60 local personnel, overseeing the procurement of a diverse range of equipment and the management and maintenance of response bases, response equipment, vehicles and boats.

Tier 1 equipment packages and trained operators are available for deployment in the field. In addition, SES equipment within the region together with its clients' and affiliates' resources can be made available, as required, to provide additional Tier 2 and 3 support.

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Pipeline Repair Services

SES recently completed the management of a major two-year project to repair an oil pipeline in the region. Repair activities included management of all civil and mechanical work associated with pipe excavation, repair sleeve fabrication and fitting, hot-tapping, by-pass and stoppel installation, and pipe replacement, wrap and coating.

Site Remediation

SES provides site and groundwater remediation services throughout the region. Recent projects include the remediation of numerous sites in the Caucasus contaminated by leaking oil pipelines and the establishment of a water sampling programme for leachate from a landfill planned for closure.



Consultancy and Training

SES has undertaken a number of environmental and emergency response consultancy projects in the region since its establishment. These projects include a review of local fire fighting capability; assessments of oil spill response containment sites and spill operations for pipeline operators; review and assessment of oil movement by rail; oil spill preparedness risk assessment for a marine terminal; and an engineering review of pipeline emergency repair capability and contingency plans.



SES has distinguished itself as a quality provider of environmental and emergency response training programmes to the oil & gas and governmental industries in the region. Training courses undertaken have included HAZWOPER, Incident Management System (ICS), a variety of Oil Spill Response courses, and Small Boat Handling Operations.

Project Management

SES' regional team has managed construction of a network of pipeline access roads and associated ancillary services in remote sections of Georgia and provided logistics support for a major pipeline river crossing in Azerbaijan.
